Baron Bloodmore and the Crimson Castle: Slot Overview

Players, take a walk on the undead side in Baron Bloodmore and the Crimson Castle, a vampire-themed slot from veteran Swedish developer Thunderkick. The studio has stepped things up for the Baron, where you'll come across a couple of classic features which have been expanded to increase their effects as well as produce a higher than normal max win figure we are used to seeing from this developer.

With a look suggestive of their Beat the Beast range, you know you are playing a Thunderkick game when Baron Bloodmore fires up. That's not a bad thing either because their graphics typically have a strong, clear quality, particularly symbols distinctive of this studio. For example, players find themselves deep within Crimson Castle, in a church-like space bathed in an eerie purple light while just below the 5-reel, 3-row grid Baron Bloodmore snoozes in his coffin, biding his time till the sun goes down.

Players can try to snatch some loot during daylight hours on any device, picking bets that range from 10 p/c to R\$ <100 per spin. For players who enjoy some hardcore gaming, volatility is high, as is potential, while RTP comes in one setting only, which is 96.15%. Like the Beat the Beast range, Baron Bloodmore is pretty straightforward, and much of the gameplay is quite traditional. For starters, 25 fixed paylines are provided to land winning combinations of 3 to 5 of a kind on to collect coins. In total, 8 pay symbols are on hand to work with, from spikey J-A card tiles to ravens, wolves, gargoyles, and Baron Bloodmore himself brooding at the top. Value-wise, premium symbols generate wins of 10 to 30 times the stake for five of a kind.

Moreover, 3 vampiric sisters appear on the wild symbols, though each one has the same capabilities. Wilds substitute for pay symbols to complete
