d poker hand. Only 1 of the dealer's 5 cards is visible. At this point, the

player &#128185; can choose to discard one or more of his cards. For each disca

rd, the player is charged a fee that &#128185; is equal to the size of the ante

bet. After making a discard selection and getting replacement cards, play is &#

128185; identical to Caribbean Stud Poker. The player must choose to either fol

d and lose the hand or raise. The raise &#128185; bet must be 2x the ante bet s

ize, so the total bet following a raise is 3x the initial bet &#128185; size. I

f the player raises, then there are several possible payouts.</p>

<p>-If the dealer has an Ace and King or better &#128185; (for example A,) Tj T\* BT /F

n the ante bet are paid and the raise bet is returned.</p>

the player wins the ante bet, and the raise bet pays according to a specific pay
